75% of the world's 900 million dogs are free-roaming, living without homes, care, or protection. Founded by Nikki Tibbles in 2015, Wild at Heart Foundation aims to compassionately reduce the number of stray dogs, and break the cycle of suffering before it starts.

Through international partnerships, we deliver sterilisation, education, and welfare programmes to improve lives. We believe every dog deserves a healthy, happy life, free from pain, cruelty, and neglect. With kindness, compassion, and community, we're creating a better world for dogs and people alike.

Wild at Heart Foundation works to deliver impactful global projects, including:

- Sterilisation: The single most effective and compassionate method of controlling the rising stray dog populations around the world. We fund sterilisation drives globally and have sterilised almost 33,000 dogs.
- Welfare: We improve the welfare of free-roaming dogs worldwide by funding vital initiatives through our project partners, including vaccinations, veterinary care, food, and shelter, to combat malnutrition, disease, and injury.
- **Education:** We aim to deliver educational programmes that promote animal welfare, empathy, and respect for dogs. Through community engagement, we have collaborated with schools and local non-profits to raise awareness and support compassionate, long-term solutions for free-roaming dogs.

Ways to Help

This is when you leave a gift to someone for a certain period of time, after which it passes to the charity. For example, you may wish for someone to live in your house for the duration of their lifetime, with the property then going to the charity upon their passing.
